

**Supporting Indonesia's G20 Presidency with Real Solutions, IDIC and Bloomberg
Organized IDIC-Bloomberg CEO Forum 2022**

In a series of side events for the Indonesian G20 Presidency, and as a concrete form of the Indonesia Deposit Insurance Corporation (IDIC) supporting the agenda of Indonesia's G20 Presidency, especially in order to spotlight Indonesia among the international community, IDIC together with Bloomberg held the IDIC-Bloomberg CEO Forum 2022, in Bali, on November 11, 2022.

"IDIC wants to provide Indonesia with the best spotlight so that the issues discussed today may also provide real solutions to support the G20 Presidency by Indonesia this year. IDIC also supports this activity by considering the huge exposure of this forum towards the international community, especially to company leaders, economists, researchers, and investors," said Chairman of the LPS Board of Commissioners, Purbaya Yudhi Sadewa, in a press conference during the international forum.

According to Purbaya, IDIC wishes for Indonesia's G20 Presidency to be noticed through the 2022 IDIC-Bloomberg CEO Forum. Meanwhile, several topics discussed include strengthening the global health sector, digital technology, renewable energy, the green economy, and Nusantara as the new capital city of Indonesia (IKN) that carries the concept of a green-smart city

"We will discuss sustainability so that it also becomes the world's attention. We also would like to inform that Indonesia's condition is very good and investors are welcomed to invest in Indonesia," he explained

Then, as an inseparable part of the issue of sustainability, this forum also discussed the concepts, opportunities, and challenges of IKN development as a green and smart city.

"In the next session we will also discuss IKN. We promote IKN so that investors understand that Indonesia is serious about building IKN and we also provide various special incentives so that they are interested in investment. IDIC itself is very serious about helping to build IKN. We are also committed to invest 250 million US dollars next year, which will be used to build infrastructure," he added

Furthermore, Purbaya stated, the IDIC-Bloomberg CEO Forum is a form of IDIC's support in participation in the success of Indonesia's G20 Presidential Summit. The various topics raised in this forum have also been in accordance with the government's priority agendas at the G20 Summit this time, namely health issues and sustainability issues.



"Through the Bloomberg CEO Forum, we hope that there will be more intense follow-up dialogues, not just speeches, but also real initiatives on the various issues discussed today," concluded Purbaya.
